

#### **Pittsburgh**

Pittsburgh is situated in Southwestern Pennsylvania in Allegheny County. The city is located within 500 miles of 70 percent of the nation's population.

#### Climate

With four distinct seasons, Pittsburgh's average temperatures range from a low of 28 degrees in January to a high of 72 degrees in July. The temperate climate creates rich green landscapes in spring and summer, and colorful foliage in autumn.

#### **Economy**

Pittsburgh offers a balanced economic base. The progressive economy grew from a once prosperous industrial community to an economy based on information and service.

#### **Transportation**

Served by the 15th busiest airport in the country, Pittsburgh's international airport ranks number two in the nation in land area and is the hub of the USAir system. Pittsburgh is the site of one of the country's largest corporate airports—Allegheny County Airport. In terms of tonnage originating and passing through a river system, Pittsburgh is the busiest inland port in the nation.

#### Corporate

Fourteen Fortune 500 companies are based in Pittsburgh, manufacturing products ranging from sauces to software. More than 600 firms are involved in the area's advanced technology industry.

#### **Education**

Higher education is the area's second largest industry. Students attend 31 colleges and universities, 95 public school districts, 233 private schools, and more than 70 vocational and trade schools.

#### **Health Care**

With an international reputation as a pioneer in transplant surgery and medical research, Pittsburgh offers health care at more than 55 area hospitals. The site of the first combined heart/liver transplant, Presbyterian University Hospital is the only facility in the world that performs all types of transplants.

#### The Arts

Rich in cultural activities, Pittsburgh is home to more than 200 active performing arts groups including the internationally acclaimed Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra and Duquesne University Tamburitzans.

#### Dining

More than 300 restaurants are located in Allegheny County, including award-winning establishments with views of the Downtown area.

#### Shopping

The Golden Triangle's ten square blocks are filled with a variety of department and specialty stores, including familiar names such as Saks and Brooks Brothers, as well as designer boutiques. Many of the city's neighborhoods feature quaint shopping areas.

#### **Sports**

Offering year-round sports events, Pittsburgh is proud of its four Superbowl trophies and World Series Titles. The Penguins are skating to the top of the NHL, while local colleges and universities are courting basketball fans.

#### Recreation

Pittsburgh offers four-season recreation ranging from boating to skiing. Allegheny County features more golf courses per capita than anywhere else in the country.




